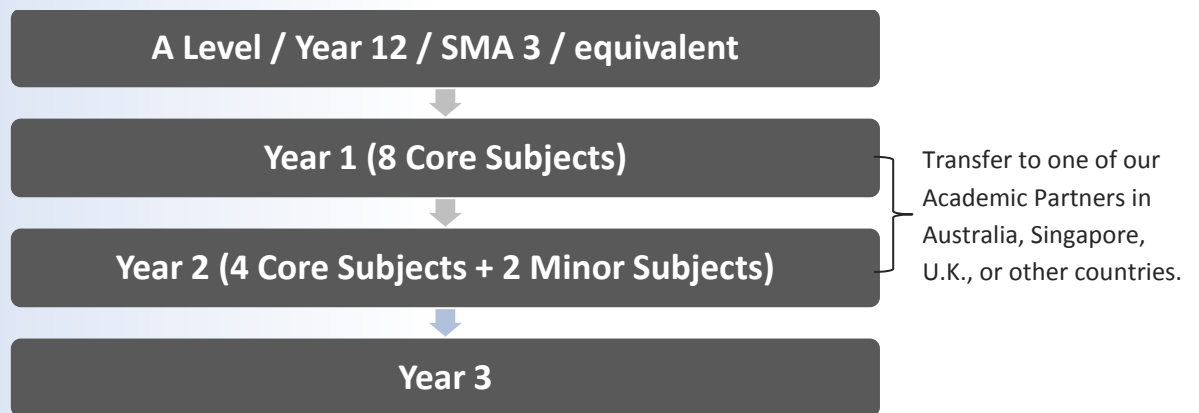


BUSINESS STUDIES PROGRAM

Students with completion of A Level / Year 12 / SMA 3 / equivalent and seeking for a University preparation program can enroll to Business Studies Program (BSP). With this program, students will be equipped with skills that meet the demands of business including Financial Accounting, Marketing, Economics, and other Business-related modules. Students will also have the opportunity to experience business fundamentals in action while working on industry projects.

Students in this course will be given a tailored program to acquire the necessary skills needed to progress to Year 2 or Year 3 of Bachelor degree program from one of our Academic Partners in Australia, Singapore, U.K., or other countries.

Admission Requirements

- SMA 3/ Year 12
Average of 7 for 5 academic subjects and 5 passes with average of 55, no marks below 50 (including English and Math), OR
- A-Level/ STPM with completion of 5 subjects with a minimum of 2 E's (including English and Math), OR
- Completion of International Foundation Program.

English Requirements

- IELTS 6.5, OR
- A pass in RC English Placement Test (min. 80).

Further Studies

Upon completing Raffles College Business Studies Program, students are able to enter **Year 2 or Year 3 of our Academic Partners**. Some of our Academic Partners also have branch campuses in other countries such as **Singapore, Malaysia, Dubai, and South Africa** where students can choose to transfer to these countries as an alternative to the University home campus.
